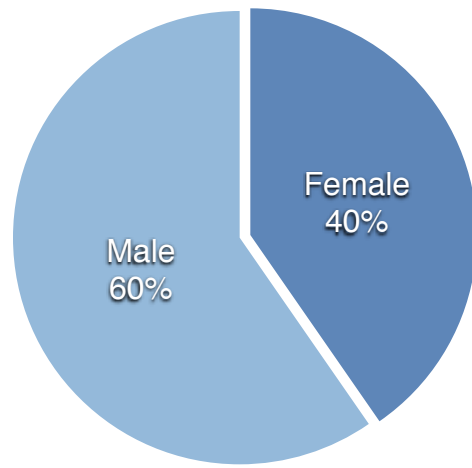

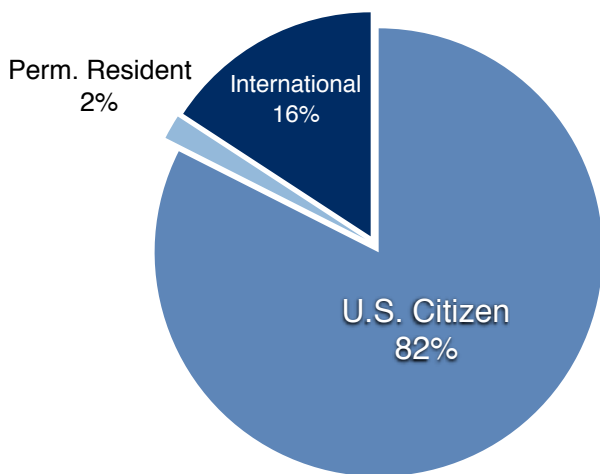

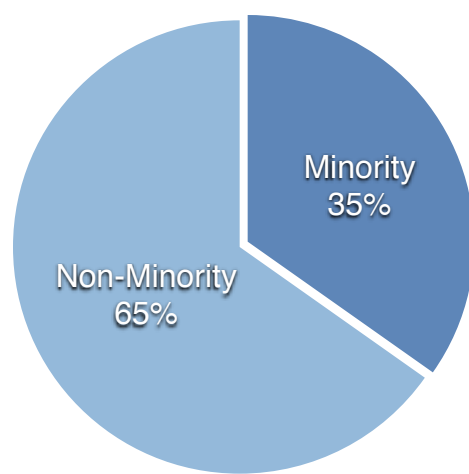

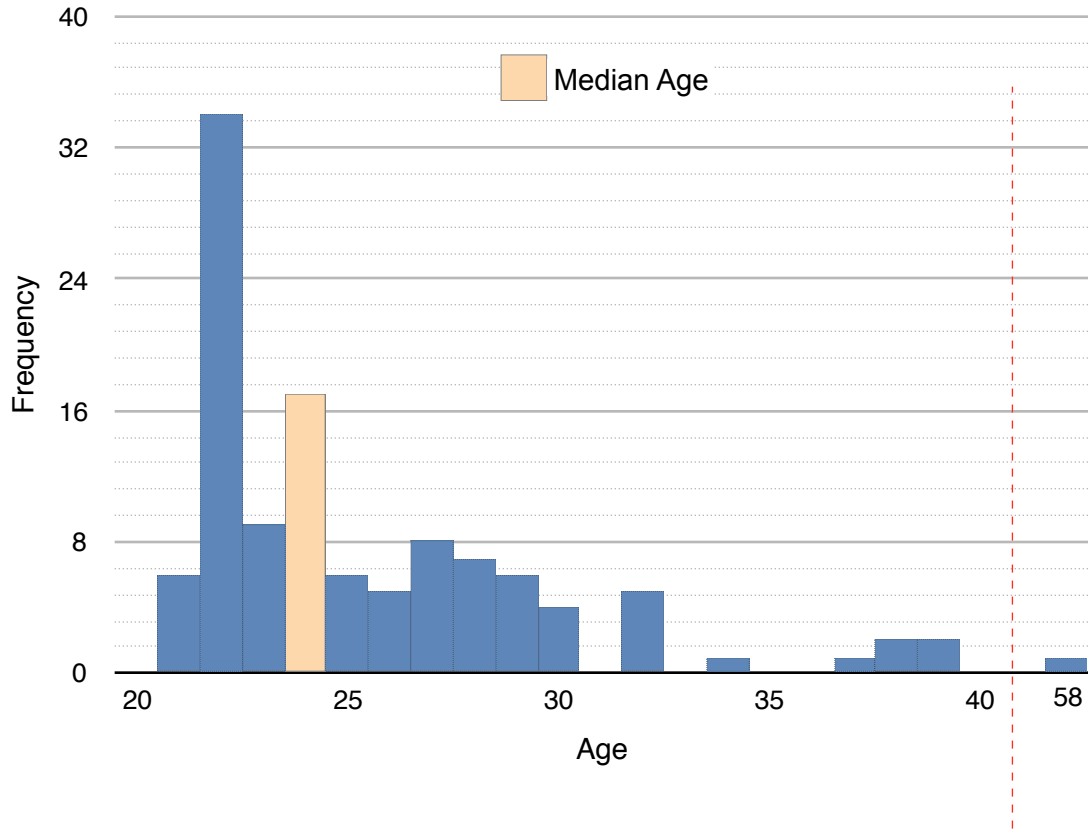

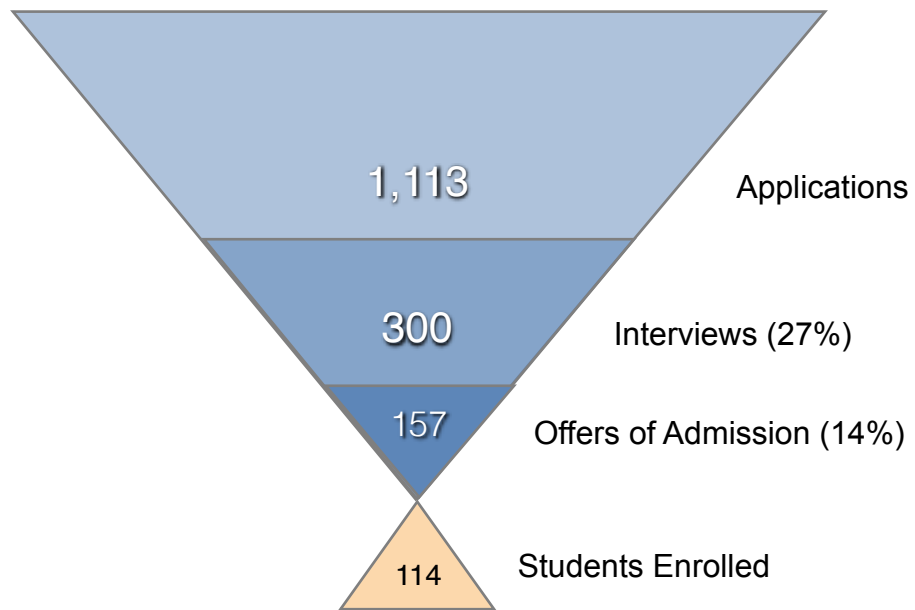
MINORITY STUDENTS



AGE DISTRIBUTION



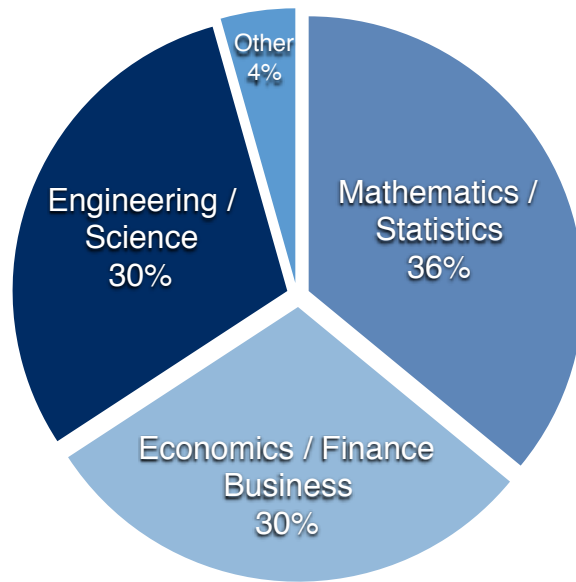

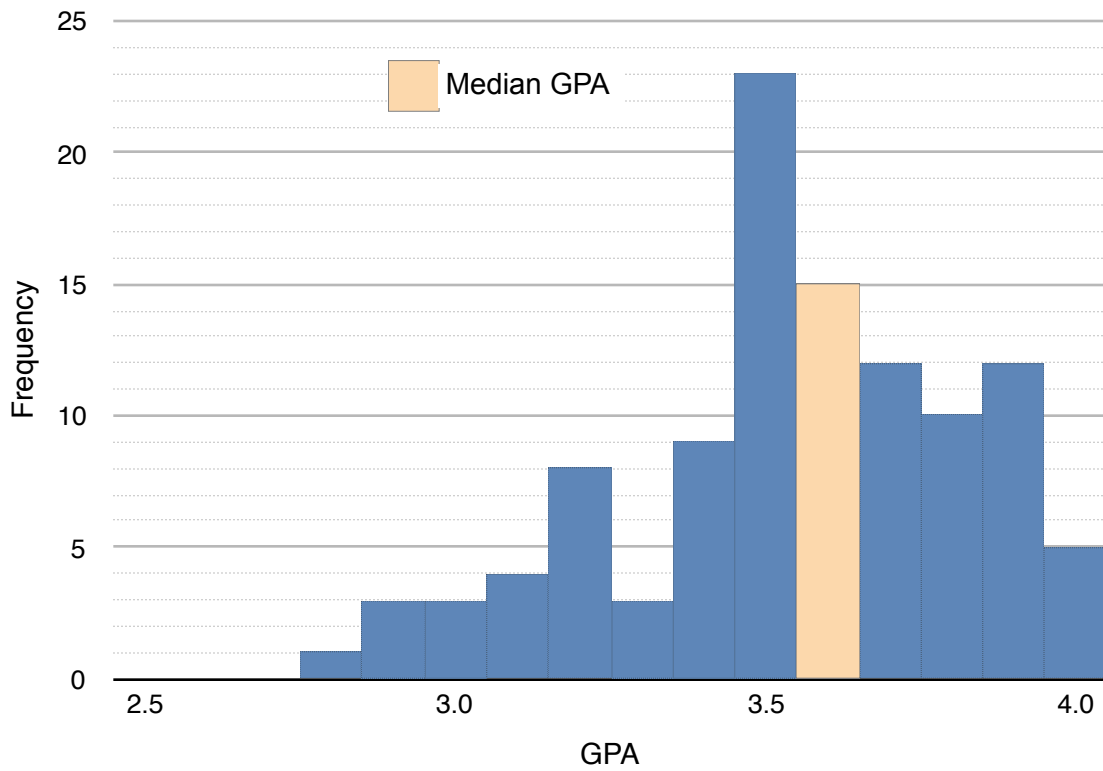

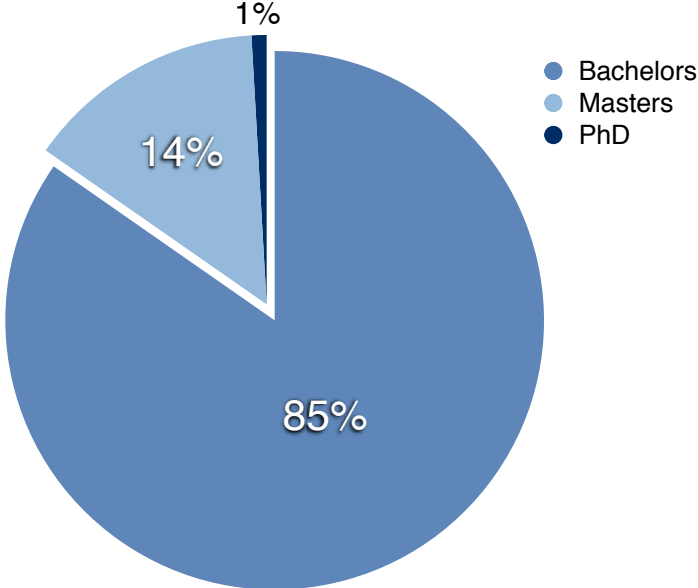
UNDERGRADUATE MAJOR



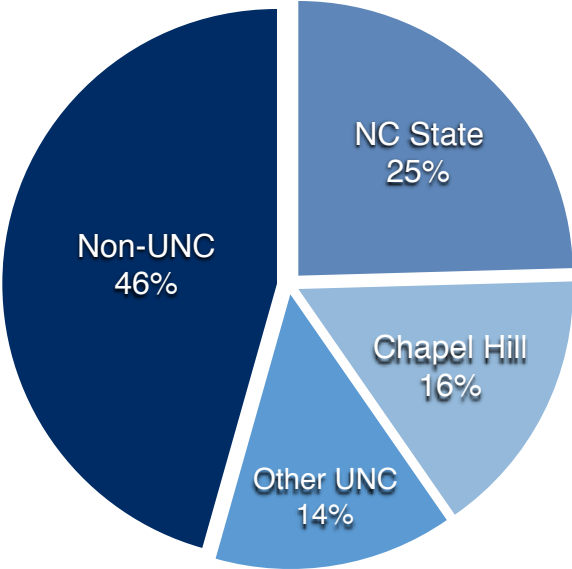
GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA) DISTRIBUTION



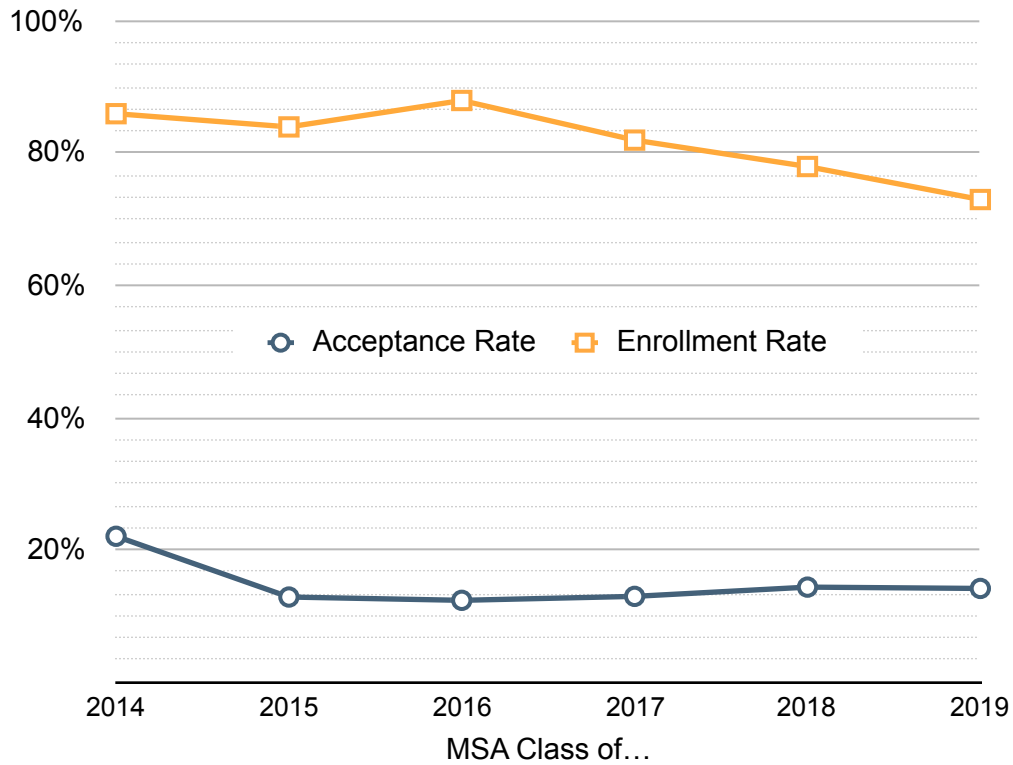
HIGHEST DEGREE ATTAINMENT

RECENT TRENDS IN ACCEPTANCE RATE AND ENROLLMENT RATE

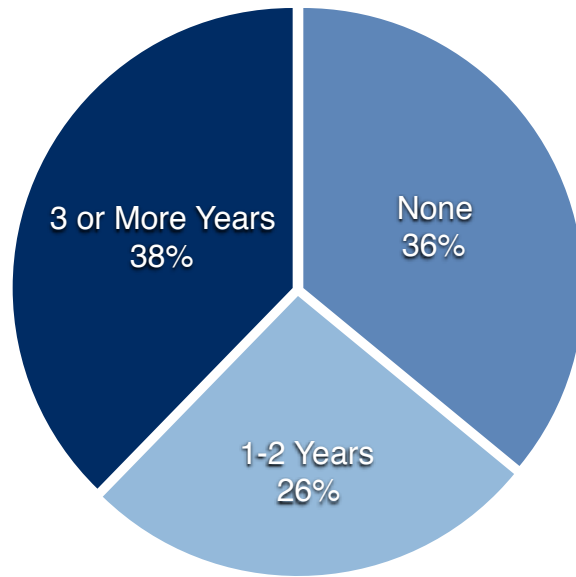
