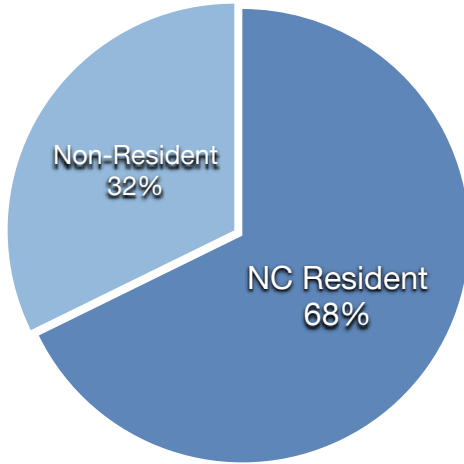

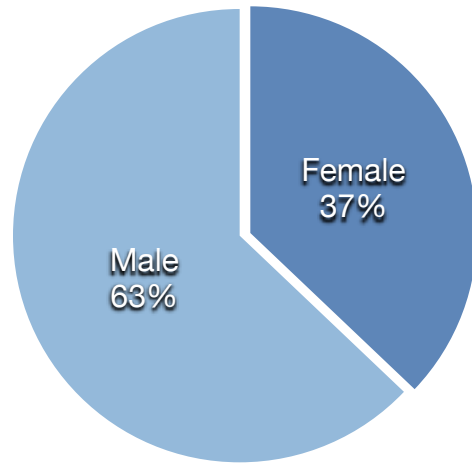

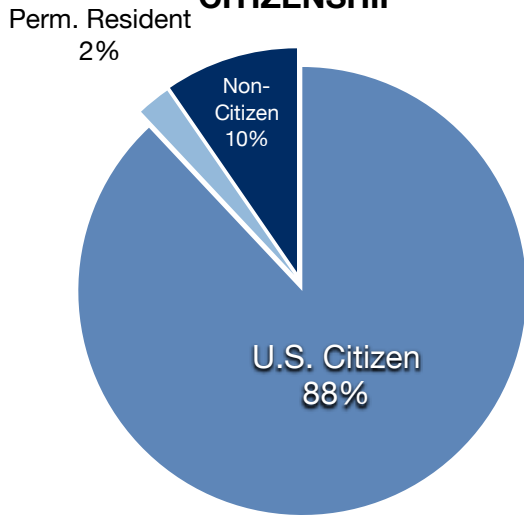

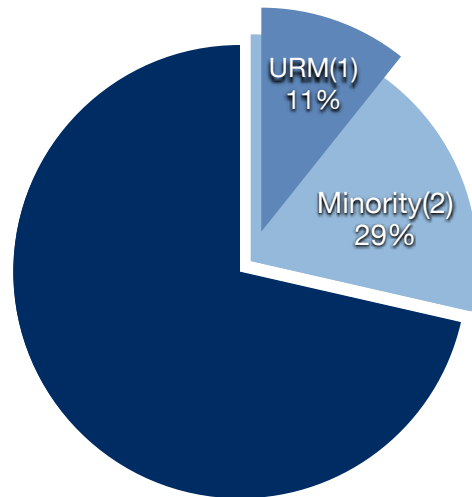

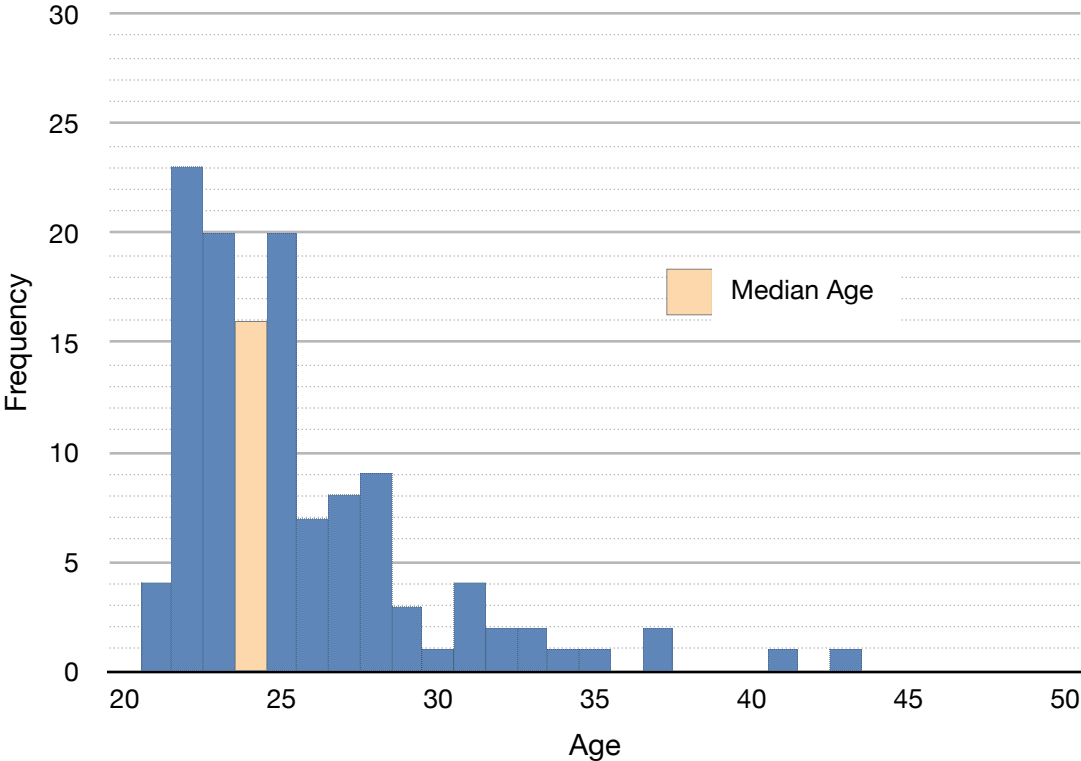

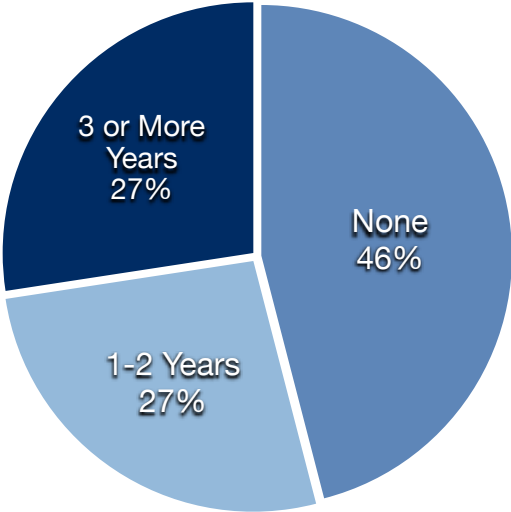

AGE DISTRIBUTION



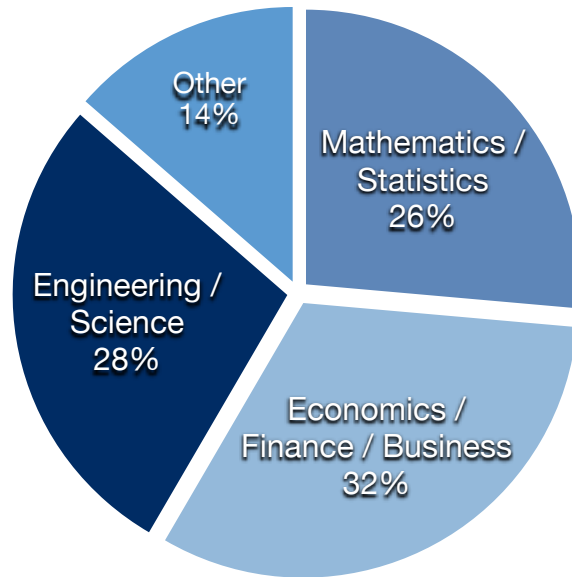

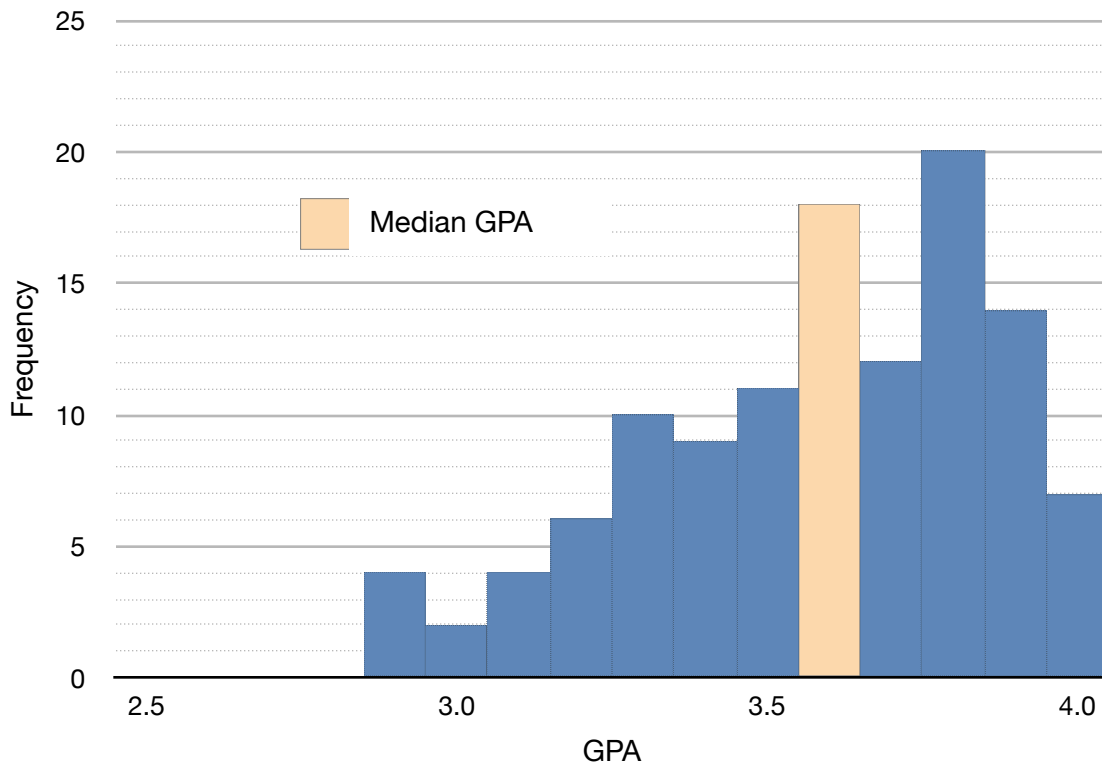

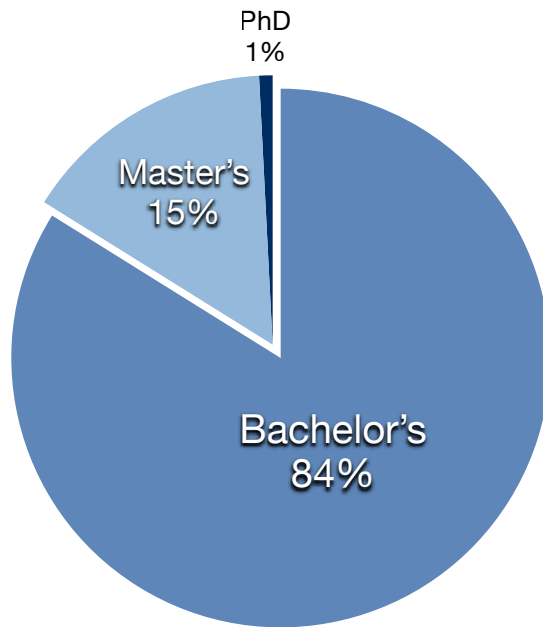
UNDERGRADUATE MAJOR



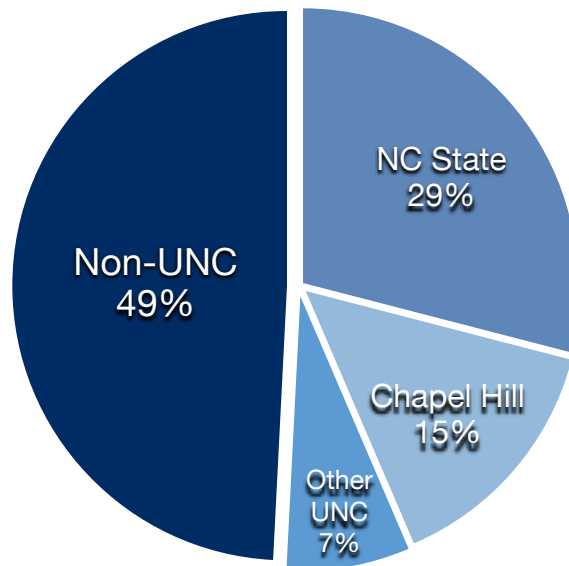
GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA) DISTRIBUTION



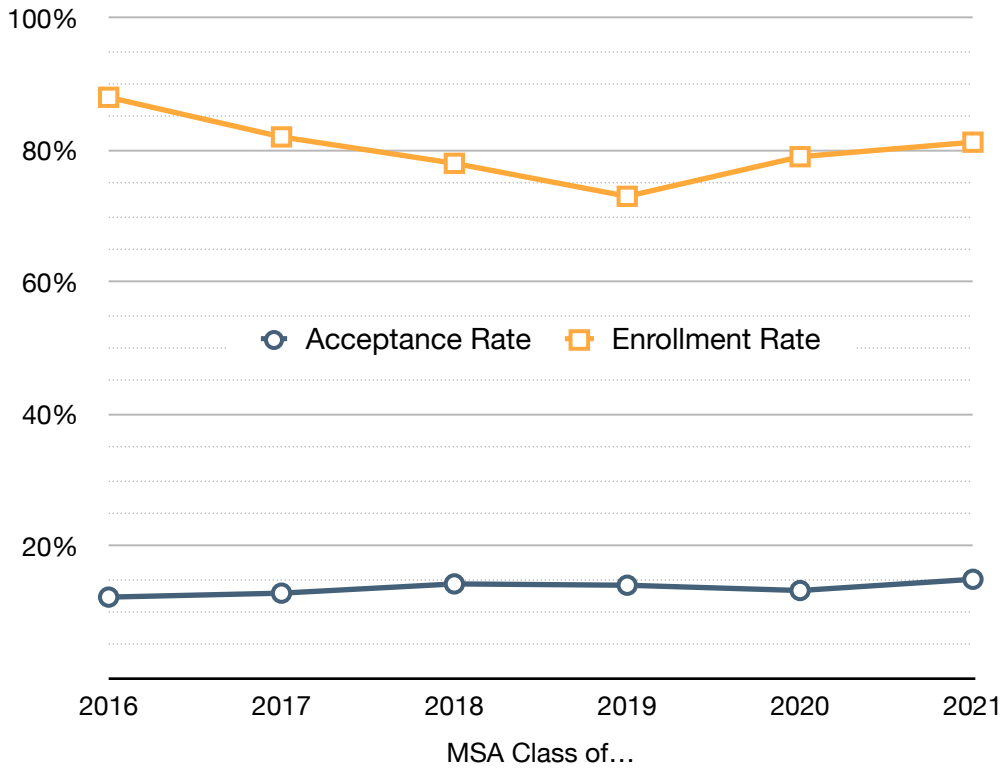
HIGHEST DEGREE ATTAINMENT



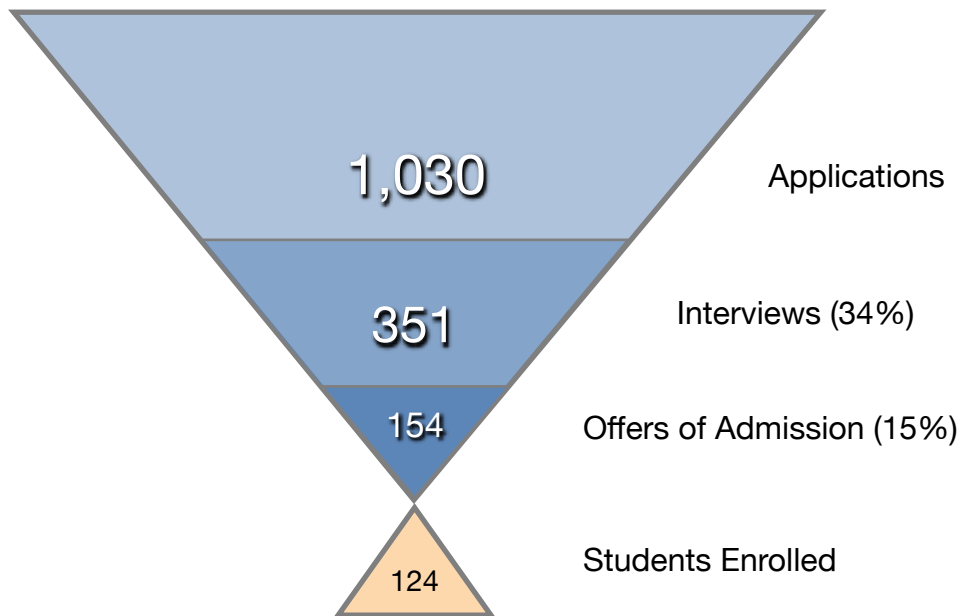
UNC SYSTEM GRADUATES



RECENT TRENDS IN ACCEPTANCE RATE AND ENROLLMENT RATE




