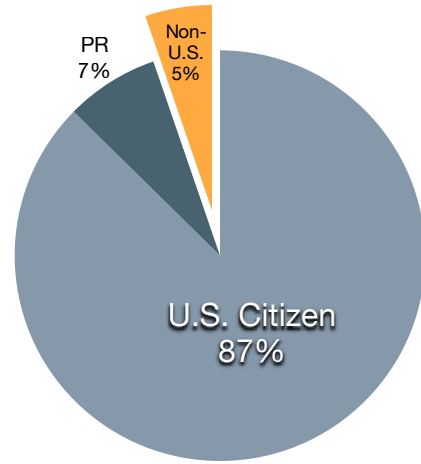

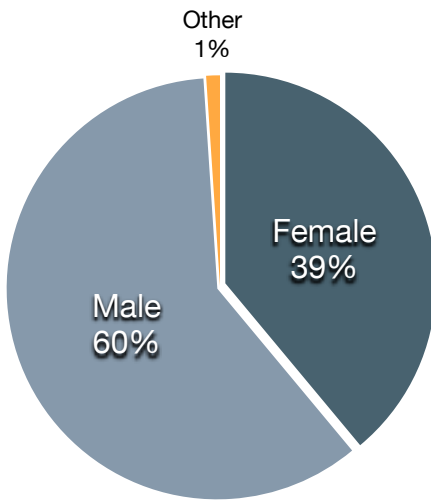

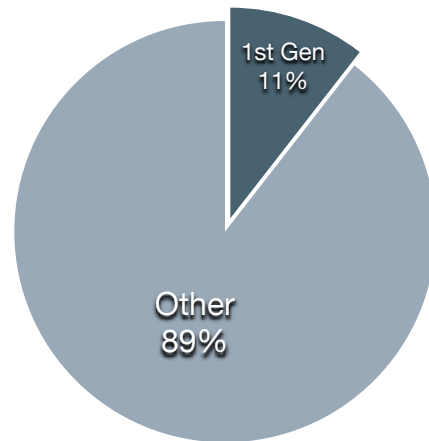

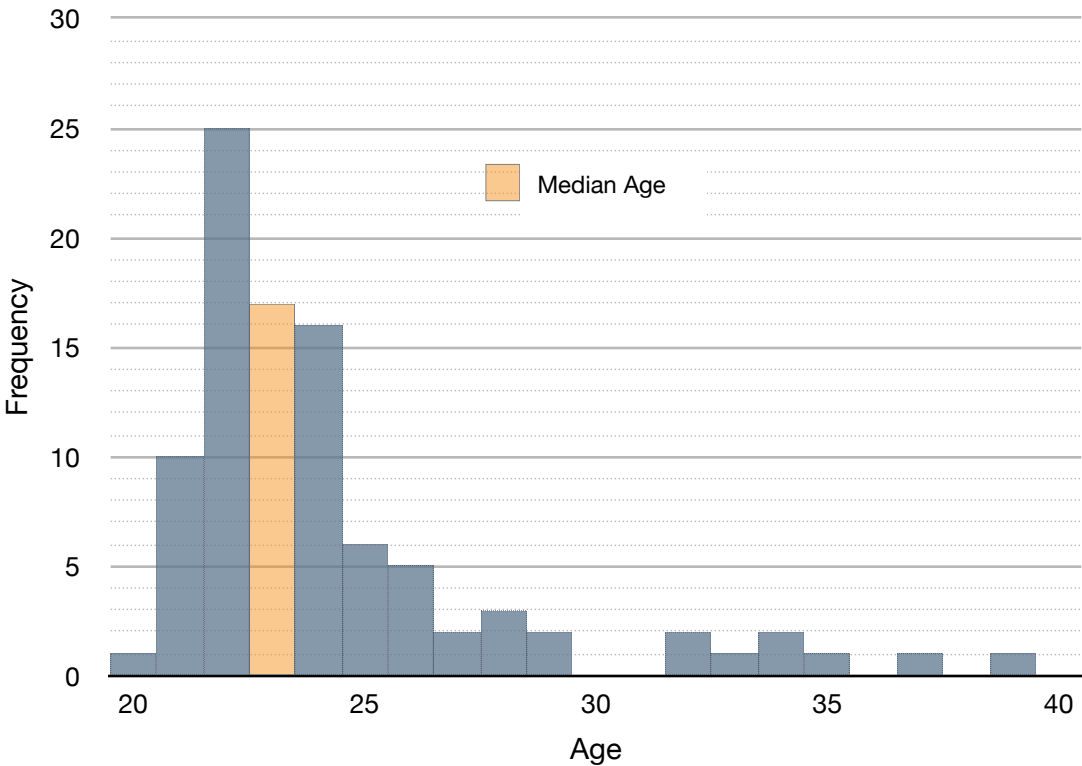
GENDER IDENTITY



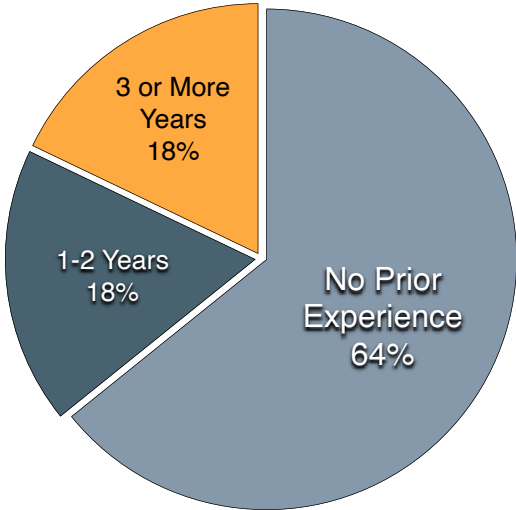
FIRST GENERATION COLLEGE STUDENT



AGE DISTRIBUTION



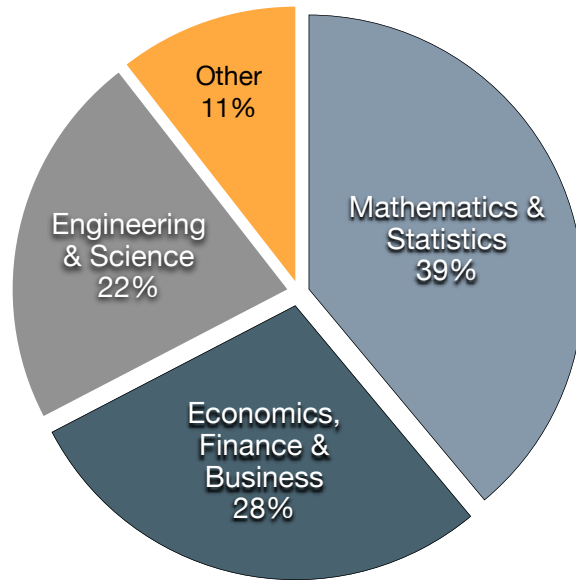

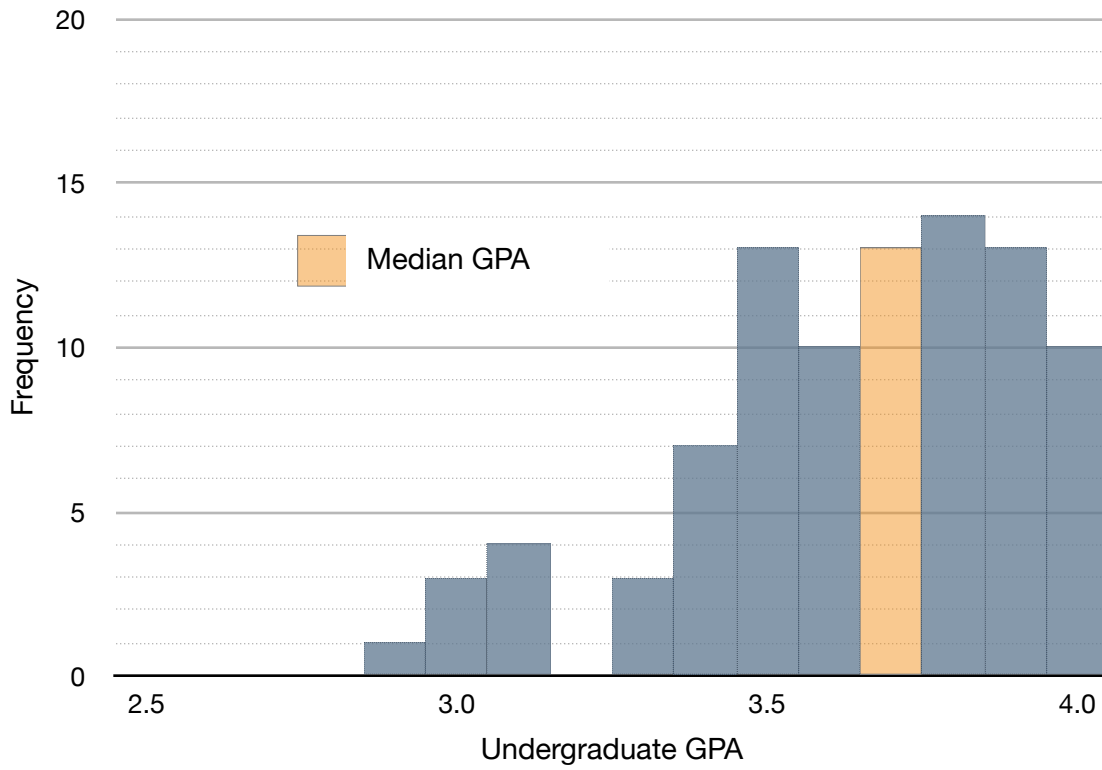

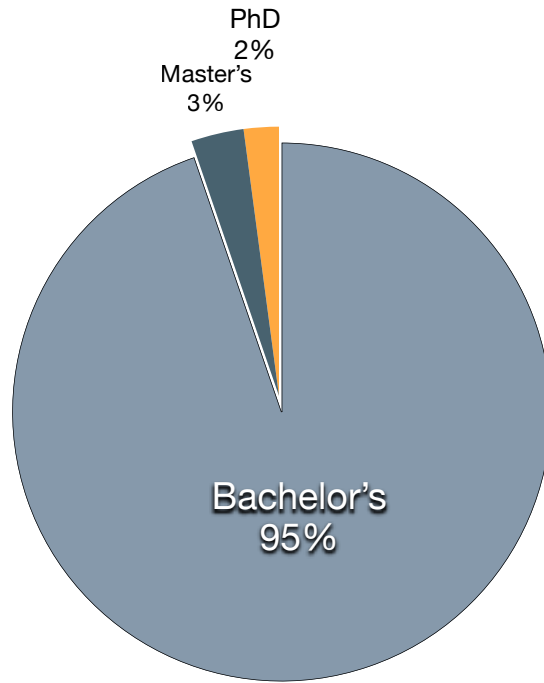
UNDERGRADUATE MAJOR



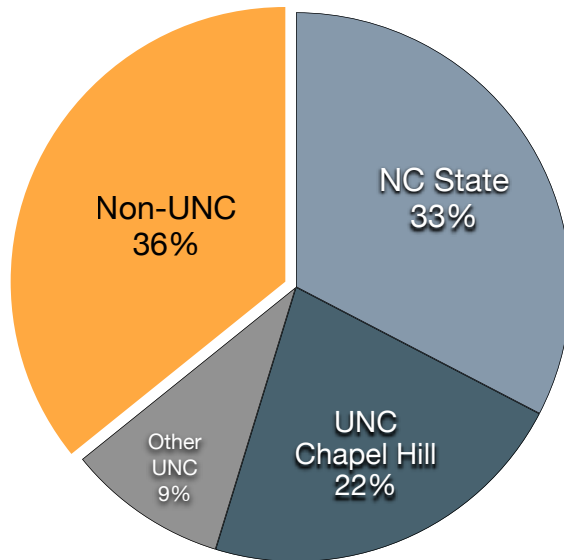
GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA) DISTRIBUTION



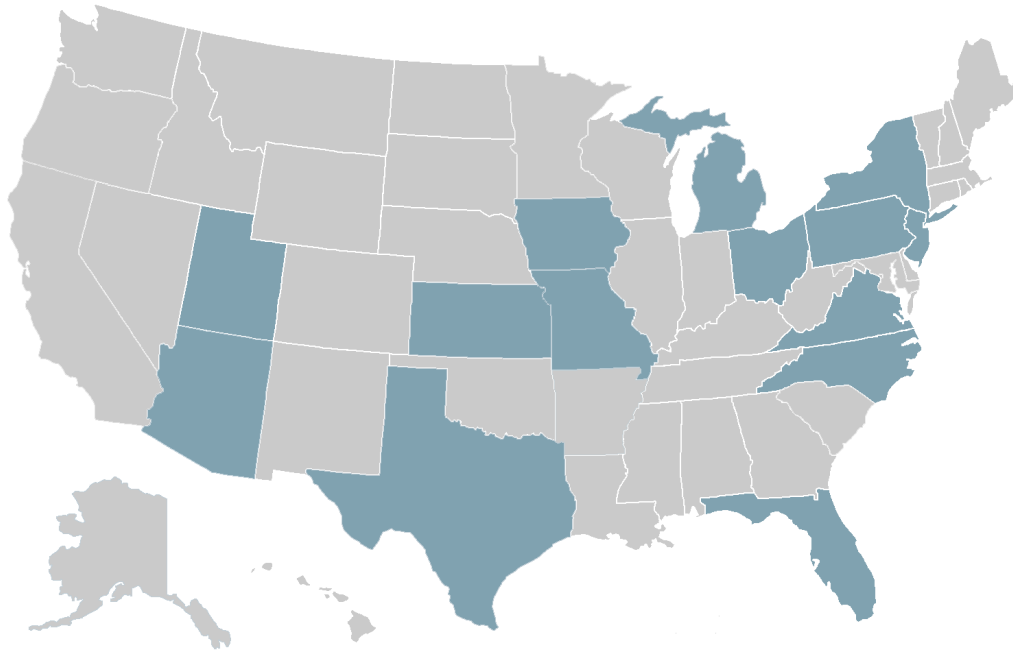
HIGHEST DEGREE ATTAINMENT



UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA SYSTEM GRADUATES



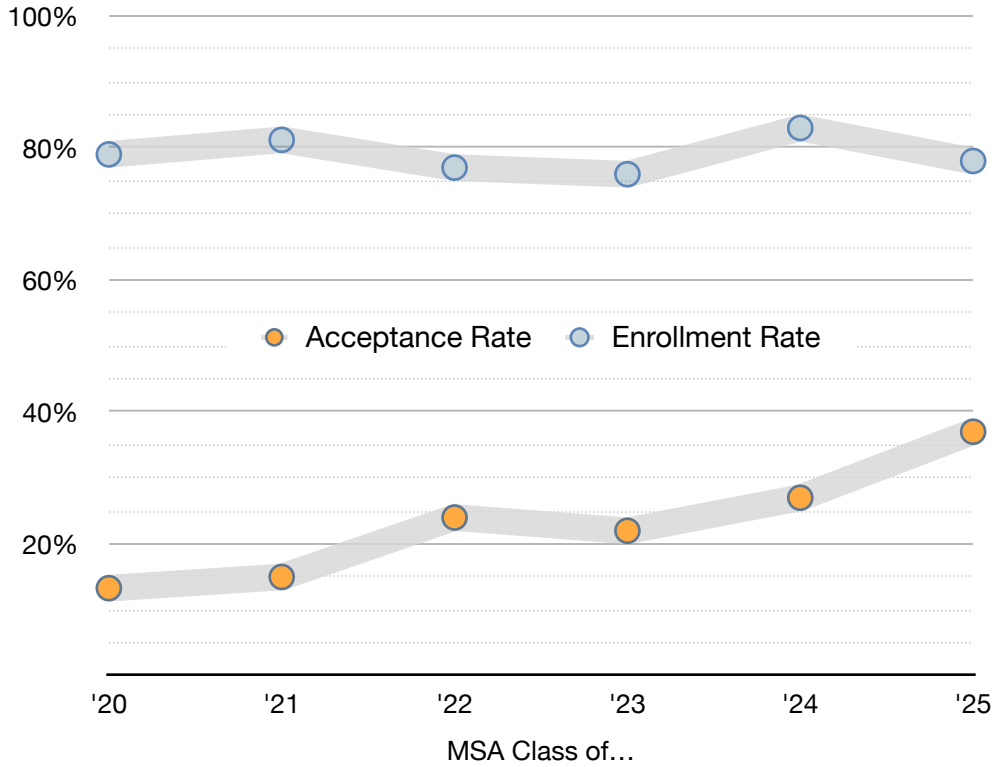
State of Residency



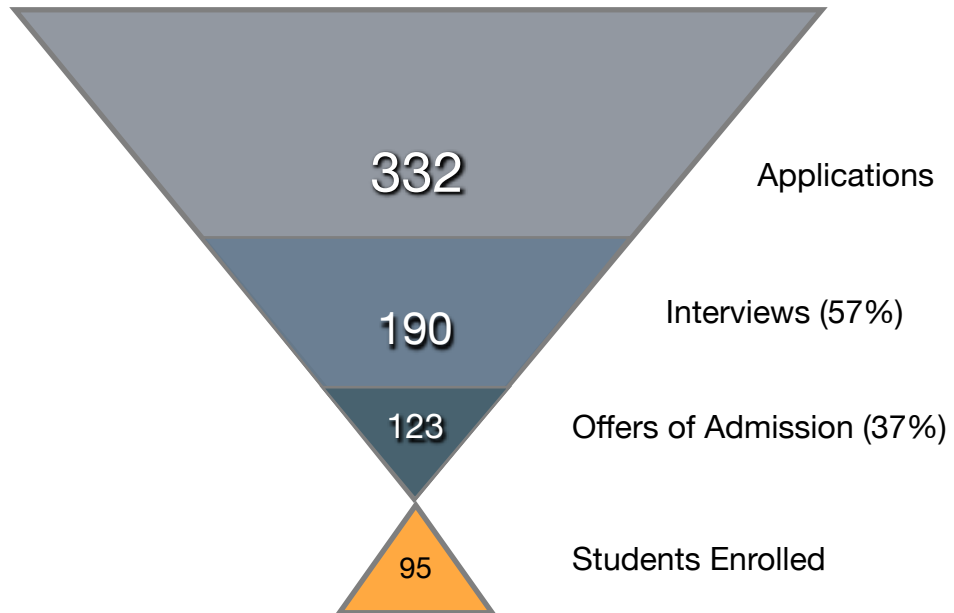
